What We Do

DEVELOP IMPACTFUL VACCINES

Prioritize vaccine candidates with limited commercial value that address outbreak-prone diseases which devastate communities in LMICs such as Marburg and Sudan ebolavirus.

SHAPE VACCINATION POLICY

Assist countries in prioritizing vaccines by evaluating the impact of new vaccines and dosing protocols for diseases like cholera and typhoid.

AMPLIFY LOCAL INSIGHTS

Support community-led research to uncover social, behavioral, and contextual factors critical to driving vaccination coverage and acceptance, particularly for lagging vaccines (e.g., HPV) and among unserved populations (e.g., zero-dose children).

BUILD LASTING CAPACITY

Strengthen individual and institutional capabilities through targeted convenings and knowledge platforms, enabling immunization professionals to connect, build leadership skills to boost vaccination rates in challenging contexts, and gain insights into new technologies.

Build diverse and multi-sector coalitions with distinctive expertise to bring holistic approaches that improve disease outcomes and tackle complex public health challenges such as cervical cancer and typhoid elimination.
